Again, the following is subject to change without advance notification:

- Monday, July 20
  - Joe leaves from the top of Elk Mountain in Susquehanna County and mountain bikes down 1,000-feet in elevation. He switches bikes and heads north up Rt. 374 hitting
  - Dimock Corners and Gelatt before turning left in Jackson to Rt. 492
  - Following Rt. 547 at Gibson, Joe will go through Harford to Kingsley
  - Near Kingsley, taking Rt. 11 South through Nicholson
  - Joe will dip down through Factoryville before heading to Dalton
  - Making his way on Rt. 632 to Waverly
    - NOON LIVE AT WAVERLY COMMUNITY HOUSE
  - Leave back on Rt. 6/11 to Clarks Summit
  - Departing Clarks Summit on Rt. 307 through Schultzville to Falls
  - Crossing the Susquehanna River and heading south on Rt. 92 to
  - West Pittston to pick up Rt. 11 again through
  - Exeter, Wyoming, Forty-Fort, Kingston, turning up Union Street to
  - Luzerne and joining Rt. 309 North through
  - Trucksville, Shavertown, Dallas, then out Rt. 415 to
  - Harveys Lake
    - The Harveys Lake Beach Club will be open to the public from 1pm-8pm with activities for the Go Joe Bike Tour

- Tuesday, July 21
  - Joe departs Dallas Shopping Center to
  - Huntsville to Chase to
  - Rt. 29 and West Nanticoke, Joe will join Rt. 11 to
  - Shickshinny, Berwick to
  - Bloomsburg
    - NOON LIVE IN BLOOMSBURG - BROAD STREET FOUNTAIN
  - Depart Bloomsburg on Rt. 11 to Danville
  - Turning onto Rt. 54 toward
  - Washingtonville, juking over to Exchange then SR 1003 to
  - Just outside Muncy , then Rt. 405 to the Lycoming County Fair
    - LIVE/STOP AT GATE 3 AT THE LYCOMING COUNTY FAIR, HUGHESVILLE

- Wednesday, July 22
  - Joe departs from Downtown Montoursville to
  - Williamsport, crossing the Susquehanna River at Rt. 15 through
  - South Williamsport to Rt. 54 to
  - Montgomery, crossing the river again following Rt. 405 through
  - Watsontown, Milton to Rt. 147 through
  - Northumberland to Sunbury
    - NOON LIVE AT SUNBURY'S CAMERON PARK
  - Leave Sunbury on Rt. 61 to
  - Shamokin, Kulpmont, Mt. Carmel, Ashland, Frackville, St. Clair, Pottsville, and Schuylkill Haven
    - LIVE/STOP AT SCHUYLKILL HAVEN'S BUBECK PARK 5P-7:30P
- Thursday, July 23
  - Joe leaves Schuylkill Haven on Rt. 443 to
  - Orwigsburg, McKeansburg, New Ringgold, picking up Rt. 895 to
  - Bowmanstown then heading south to Palmerton
  - Taking back-way out of Palmerton to Beltsville, then Rt. 209 through
  - Weissport and Lehighton
    - NOON LIVE AT LEHIGHTON TOWN PARK
  - Leave Lehighton on Rt. 902 to New Mahoning over Mauch Chunk Ridge to
  - Summit Hill and Landsford, then Rt. 209 through
  - Coaldale to Tamaqua, turning north on Rt. 309 to
  - Hometown, McAdoo and Hazleton, turning on Rt. 940 through
  - Harleigh, Oakdale, and Jeddo to
  - Freeland
    - LIVE/STOP AT FREELAND PUBLIC PARK 5P-7:30P
- Friday, July 24
  - Joe leaves from White Haven on Rt. 940 to
  - Blakeslee Corner, Pocono Summit, Mt. Pocono, then right onto Rt. 611 to
  - Mt. Airy Resort
    - NOON LIVE AT MT. AIRY RESORT
  - Leave on Rt. 611 toward Swiftwater, then left on Rt. 715 to
  - Henryville, then left onto Rt. 191 through
  - Paradise Valley, Cresco, to Mountainhome, turning onto Rt. 390 to
  - Canadensis, then left onto Rt. 447 to
  - Newfoundland to Rt. 507 around Lake Wallenpaupack,
  - Then left on Rt. 6/590 to Hawley
    - LIVE/STOP AT HAWLEY BINGHAM PARK 5P-7:30P
- Saturday, July 25
  - Joe leaves Hawley at his leisure to St. Joseph's Festival Telethon LIVE on WNEP-TV via:
  - Rt. 6 to Honesdale, Prompton, turning north on Rt. Rt. 296 and
  - Around to Forest City by way of Rt. 247, leaving town on Rt. 171 to
  - Carbondale, then to the Festival Grounds at Marywood University
  - Arriving at Festival during broadcast: 7pm-10pm
